

SPOT SORTING INSTRUCTIONS

Biowaste and combustible waste that is collected separately from properties



BIOWASTE

Biogas produced from biowaste is recovered as energy in a biogas plant, and nutrients are recycled into Ranu soil conditioner granules.

For example

- food leftovers and other foodstuffs
- coffee grounds, filter bags and tea bags
- fruit and vegetable peelings

Pour liquids and liquid food onto a few layers of newspaper or an egg carton at the bottom of a container and allow the paper or carton to absorb the liquid.



These do not belong in biowaste:

- garden waste (take to waste station)
- animal waste, cat litter and other pet cage material
- eggshells
- large bones
- disposable plates and cutlery, including biodegradable ones (see more detailed sorting instructions)



COMBUSTIBLE WASTE

Combustible waste is recovered as energy in a waste-to-energy plant.

For example

- extremely dirty paperboard and plastic packaging with product inside
- used hygiene products, such as nappies and sanitary towels
- eggshells
- plastic products (other than plastic packaging), such as toys and plastic and freezer containers
- animal waste, cat litter and other pet cage material
- large bones

SPOT SORTING INSTRUCTIONS

Packaging waste that is collected separately from properties

Please deposit these in your housing association's waste container
or four-compartment container, or take them to an eco point, waste station or RE-point.



CARTON PACKAGES

For example

- milk and juice cartons, cereal and biscuit packaging
- toilet and kitchen roll tubes
- paper bags
- cardboard boxes, paper-board packaging fillers and other household paperboard packaging
- disposable paperboard cups and takeaway food containers

Please ensure they are empty, clean, dry, flattened and packed inside each other.



GLASS PACKAGES

- glass jars and bottles

Please ensure they are empty, clean and dry. Remove lids and caps.



METAL PACKAGES

For example

- cans, aluminium foil containers and aluminium foil
- metal lids, caps and closures
- aerosol cans that are completely empty (no sloshing or hissing)
- other small metal household items

Please ensure they are empty, clean and dry.



PLASTIC PACKAGES

For example

- food and detergent packaging
- plastic bags and wrapping
- plastic bottles, canisters and tubs
- styrofoam packaging
- disposable plastic cups and takeaway food containers

Please ensure they are empty. Separate lids, caps and pump applicators from their containers.
